



## **Synopsis of Species and Attacks Since Relocation**

### **The Breen**

On December 3, 2384, Sky Harbor Aegis was relocated to this area of space in response to a growing threat from the Breen. Shortly thereafter, the Breen mounted a massive attack on the station, only to disappear just short of its goal. At that point it was feared they had cloaked and would uncloak in formation around the station. They never reappeared. Captain Halloway, who has taken the *USS Yorktown* into Breen space to investigate, reported that Breen colonies have also mysteriously disappeared. Presently, the *USS Yorktown* and the *USS Missouri*, along with Starfleet Intel Special Operations is in ongoing investigation.

### **The Athra**

On April 1, 2385, the station was attacked by a previously unknown species similar to the Athra of myth and legend. A monstrous mother ship appeared, from which hundreds of small fighter-like craft emerged. When one fighter crashed into the Midway, Aegis' staff analyzed the craft. They found that the pilot was fully integrated with the space craft and their technology was advanced beyond anything previously encountered. According to Dr. Feretti, Chief of Science and a telepath, the fighter pilots communicated telepathically with the mother ship.

The Athra appeared shortly after the archaeological colony on TKR-117 discovered a buried city and began excavations. However, the colony itself was not attacked. The Athra attacked the station twice, but have not returned since the archaeological dig on TKR-117 was abandoned in the wake of the parasite outbreak. Whether the archaeological dig had anything to do with the Athra's appearance has not been determined.

The exact location of the Athra home world and the area of space they inhabit remains a mystery.

### **The Dolatees and Subspace Parasites**

In July of 2386, several large, whale-like creatures passed through the system. Though the Dolatees appeared benign, they carried subspace parasites that had a taste for deuterium and all bonding metals, including titanium, but they do not digest processed silica.

Benign while riding on the Dolatees, the parasites came in contact with the shuttle sent to observe them and were transferred to the station when the shuttle landed. They feasted for a period of time, then rest, during which time they multiply. While Aegis personnel were diagnosing the problem, the parasites caused breaches in several areas of the hull. Station personnel were evacuated to the *USS Missouri*. Before the parasites were neutralized, the station sustained considerable damage.

### **The Tjurakh**

The most recent development and potential threat to Aegis, the Tjurakh are a loose confederation of warlords spread over several worlds in our sector. They have suddenly come upon financial and material backing and tactical training to be able to mount decisive attacks close to and just inside Federation and Allied space, the last of which was inside Ferengi Space.

The recent shakeup in the Ferengi government points to a plot by a group that is supporting the Tjurakh for their own financial gain. This information was revealed to Cdr Chirakis by Ambassador Drankum when he returned to Aegis. Only a few others (Jint, Grand Nagus Rom, and the Ferengi government) know the Ferengi-Tjurakh connection. The Ferengi government is still investigating.
